

The Quadrilateral Mutual Recognition Agreement is between ASHA, the Canadian Association of Speech-Language Pathologists and Audiologists (CASLPA), the Royal College of Speech and Language Therapists (RCSLT) in the United Kingdom, and the Speech Pathology Association of Australia Limited only. It does not include any of the state licensing boards because each licensing board has specific requirements that must be met.

The following statement is part of the actual agreement “Whereas the Signatory Associations recognize that this Agreement does not apply to such licensing or registration; and Whereas the Signatory Associations further recognize that all individuals applying under this Agreement will, in addition to the terms addressed in this Agreement, also need to meet any other legal or other requirements that may be imposed though national, state or provincial licensing or registration in order to practice.”
